


**1. General introduction :**

Thank you for purchasing our FC-1 foot controller. This foot controller is small, portable and will control our "QTX Light" range of slimline par cans. It has three buttons with LED digital display readout, so you know exactly what you're doing. This is a great product for musicians and performers who want to change the lighting scene at the press of a button.

**Features :**

- Simple 3 button operation: colour, mode, blackout
- Colour mode: 9 selectable colour washes
- Mode options: Sound-to-light, auto colour scroll or sound-to-light strobe
- Adjustable sound to light sensitivity
- Can control up to 50 par cans
- LED digital display
- Compact and light weight
- Supplied with 6m DMX cable
- Compatible with QTX slimline par cans (152.778UK, 152.779UK & 152.780UK)

This product contains no user serviceable parts so make no attempt to try to fix or modify this item yourself as you may invalidate the warranty. We recommend you keep the original package and proof of purchase for any possible replacement or returned demand.

**3. Caution :**

For your safety, please kindly pay attention to all of the warnings below:

- Always plug in the power plug last and disconnect from the mains, when the device is not in use or before cleaning.
- Do not operate the device in rain or extreme heat, moisture or dusty environments.
- This device is for indoor use only and in a dry environment.
- Do not switch on immediately but wait until it reaches room temperature, if the device has been exposed to drastic temperature fluctuations.
- Do not shake the device and avoid excessive force when installing or operating



Press the "Black out" button to turn the Par cans on/off. The LED display will then turn off when this button is pressed but will flash when you use the "Colour" or "Mode" buttons to ready the next option.



- Do not use the device during thunderstorms and please disconnect the power.
- Do not use solvents or aggressive detergent to clean the device. Use a soft and clean cloth.
- Do not modify the device or the connected power cord without authorization.

#### 4. Connect with power supply:

Use the power supply provided to connect to the main power supply.

#### 5. General maintenance :

To maintain optimum performance and minimize wear unplug fixture from mains before conducting maintenance. Use a vacuum or air compressor and a soft brush to remove dust collected on external vents and internal components. Cleaning frequently depends on the environment in which the fixture operates: damp, smoky or particularly dirty surroundings can require cleaning fluid. Always dry the parts carefully.

#### 6. Quick trouble shooting :

- 6.1 If the unit does not function – Check that the main power is on in working order
- 6.2 If the unit is not reacting to music – check the unit is in “sound to light” mode and that the sensitivity control is fully clockwise.
- 6.3 If the product is not reacting to DMX signals, check the cables and connections
